Master's Degree Final Project (IVI): "Influence of Sperm Donor Body Mass Index on the Reproductive Outcomes of Artificial Insemination Cycles with Donor Sperm" This study analyses the impact of body mass index (BMI) of sperm donors on the success of intrauterine insemination cycles with donor sperm (IUI-D). The results showed no significant differences in live birth rate or other reproductive outcomes when comparing normal-weight and overweight donors. Although the increasing number of overweight donors suggests that this factor does not negatively affect IUI-D outcomes, more research is needed to analyse the impact of obesity and other indicators on the health of offspring.
